KIDS MINISTRY VISION:

To see every child come to KNOW Jesus, GROW with Jesus, and GO share Jesus.

Purpose:

To assist Kids Ministry Pastor and Director during the summer months with Kids Ministry activities, discipleship, and relationships with children.

Qualifications:

- Agreement with FBCO's Values, Doctrine, and Biblical Guidelines for Personal Discipleship and Ministry.
- Demonstration of spiritual maturity and integrity.
- A desire and commitment to actively develop skills in ministry leadership.
- Spiritual gifts or abilities which may include leadership, mercy, encouragement, and pastoring.
- Commitment to full participation at FBCO during the internship.
- Ability to lead and deploy teams of people in order to accomplish events and tasks.
- Strong team player; good follow-through with people and tasks.
- Demonstration of a passion and love for working with children.
- Ability to interact well with parents and other adults.
- Must have completed a minimum of freshman year in college.

Roles and Responsibilities (extended):

Kids ministry positions at FBCO are organized around 4 core roles. Together, these express a philosophy of ministry leadership in which interns will be trained.

- 1. Member of a Team, under Supervision and alongside Co-Workers
- Receive training, guidance, and supervision from the Kids Min staff.
- Lead and work collaboratively as a summer intern team with other interns.
- Work collaboratively with other FBCO staff as needed.
- 2. <u>Leadership Development</u>, i.e., developing our skills and multiplying ministry through others.
- Receive active training and hands-on experience in leading a kids ministry.
- Discover and develop one's gifts in ministry leadership in a supportive atmosphere.
 Specific areas of development include self-care while leading ministry, program design and execution, public speaking, leading discussion groups, leading others in local mission, and weekly time management.
- As well as being developed as leaders, a summer intern will be involved in developing other leaders. Specifically, you will be responsible for leading and assisting returning adults and college students who volunteer to help out in the ministry during the summer.
- 3. Direct Ministry with Children
- Initiate and build relationships with children.
- Pray regularly with and for children.
- 4. Program Leadership
- Assist in the planning and execution of the program elements involved in the summer ministry. This may include teaching, leading a discipleship group, organizing an activity, etc.
